## **Questions:**

- 2. Most people believe John is the "disciple whom Jesus loved." See for example <u>John 19:26</u>. Why do people think that? Assuming it is John, why do you think Jesus referred to him in this manner?
- 3. Why was John exiled and given such great revelation (see Book of <u>Revelation</u>) when other disciples were martyred?
