Week Seven

Great People of the Bible: King Solomon

Suggested Scripture (not all inclusive): 1 Kings, 2 Kings, 1 Chronicles, 2 Chronicles, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Songs

Questions:

- 1. One of great lessons from the Bible is found in <u>1 Kings 3</u> when Solomon asked God for wisdom. Solomon received both wisdom and (by God's grace) wealth. How well did he use these gifts from God? Was he wise?
- 2. Much is said of Solomon's 700 wives and 300 concubines (see <u>1 Kings 11:3</u>). Why did God allow this? Was it wrong?
- 3. Solomon's early reign as king was the "golden age" for Israel. It was a time when Israel had great wealth and prosperity and was a kingdom united. Solomon's reign ended with a divided kingdom; one that would never again be united in peace. What caused the downfall? Could it have been avoided?
