Questions:

- 3. Paul, who was maybe the greatest church planter of all time, was one of the greatest missionaries, and wrote most of New Testament (including four books from prison), advanced the gospel throughout his time and the ages. What is the <u>one</u> thing you think propelled Paul's ministry more than anything else, other than Christ?
