### Week Fourteen

#### Verses for the week: Hebrews Chapter 11:1-2

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. This is what the ancients were commended for.

#### Questions:

1. The definition of faith in verse 1 has two descriptions; it says, “Faith is [1] the assurance of things hoped for, [2] the conviction of things not seen.”

From your own life, can you give a faith example of [1] the assurance of something you have hope for and [2] the conviction of something you have not seen?

2. Verse 2 says, “for by [faith] the people of old received their commendation.”

What does this verse tell you about God?
