Week Seven

Great Events of the Bible: God's People Enter the Promised Land

Suggested Scripture: Joshua 1:1–9 and Chapter 3

Questions:

1. In <u>Chapter 1</u>, <u>Verses 1-9</u>, God is instructing and encouraging Joshua for the task ahead (the ultimate pre-game talk). What **seven (7)** <u>commands</u> and **seven (7)** <u>promises</u> did God give Joshua in the "talk"?

Do these commands and promises still apply to us today?

2. In <u>Chapter 3</u>, Joshua gives the People **two (2)** specific <u>commands</u> from God about how they should <u>prepare for</u> and <u>enter</u> the Promised Land (which for the People of God, was "living out" the will of God for their lives promised to Abraham generations before).

What were the **two (2)** <u>commands</u> from God? Do they still apply to us today as we "live out" the will of God in our lives?

3. In <u>Chapter 1</u>, God appoints Joshua to succeed Moses and lead the People into Promised Land. Why was Moses not allowed to enter the Promised Land?
