Great Events of the Bible: God's People Enter the Promised Land

Suggested Scripture: Joshua 1:1–9 and Chapter 3

Questions:

1. In Chapter 1, Verses 1-9, God is instructing and encouraging Joshua for the task ahead (the ultimate pre-game talk). What **seven (7) commands** and **seven (7) promises** did God give Joshua in the “talk”?

Do these commands and promises still apply to us today?

2. In Chapter 3, Joshua gives the People **two (2) specific commands** from God about how they should prepare for and enter the Promised Land (which for the People of God, was “living out” the will of God for their lives promised to Abraham generations before).

What were the **two (2) commands** from God? Do they still apply to us today as we “live out” the will of God in our lives?

3. In Chapter 1, God appoints Joshua to succeed Moses and lead the People into Promised Land. Why was Moses not allowed to enter the Promised Land?
