UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- 1) Heritage Center building entrance paint and repairs-Bill 2026
- 2) Level area at entrance so ice doesn't form as easily in 2025-Trina in the fall
- 3) Improve the area around the Canyon Echoes sign to make it more visible from the west parking area. We need large equipment to move the boulders. We have permission to use the benches made by the Chamber. May move to 2026.
- 4) Add sign we have for Parking on West side.
- 5) Grants- Grant and Jim attended the Land and Water Trust in Fairplay a second time.

- 6) Pavillion/Bandstand updated report from Grant.
- 7) Caboose repairs and updates with solar. New battery delivered to Heritage Center.
- 8) Paint restroom doors-Suzi has painted the Ladies restroom door. The door frames need Rust-oleum paint. Gents door still needs paint. Foot not healed.
- 9) Winterize Restrooms after Fall Festival on Oct. 26th? Bill
- 10) Store all valuables in buildings into totes to keep them protected for the winter. Must be done before dark in Oct or Nov.
- 11) Who will be available to decorate the park with lights and Christmas trees? Set dates now so there are plenty of people to help.
- 12) Linda and Becky know a group of Plein Air Artists Colorado who have done work at South Park City. They are professional artists who offered to come look at our park during an Open House and will paint the trash cans for free. Jim has emailed Ann Lukacs and she says it may take a while (next year) to get the artists together. The dumpsters on Main St. were painted by a group of artis and volunteers last week. Do we want to consider other options?

Projects Completed

- 1) Schoolhouse door was painted by Bill.
- 2) Grant and Wesley installed the wooden door to replace the one on the shed. It took some work and nearly $\frac{1}{2}$ a day to make it fit!
- 3) Wesley and Grant also installed the lattice to make that area look better and Trina donated bougainvillea plants. They will be stored inside for the winter.
- 4) Welsey and Tanya removed weeds and planted succulents by the Heritage Center. Wesley also dug up grass and weeds along the Wren Cabin to add flowers. I've been wanting that for years. He and Bev made it happen!

NEW BUSINESS

- 1) Bill and Jim met with Scott and set up the website with PayPal for memberships, books, and donations.
- 2)Trina has a card reader we can use for credit card sales during an Open House or event. She has given Suzi and Bill instructions and we can pass those instructions on.
- 3) Bill fixed the Gents restroom door that was not closing.
- 4) Jim added a bucket for mice in the schoolhouse.
- 5) Becky reminded us that Jim Sapp would tell us that all we do for PCHS needs to have something to do with history of Park County. Please name events accordingly.
