Turnaround time from the receipt of the application is usually 6-8 weeks. ***Please provide any information you have that may qualify your property.***

I/we acknowledge that the plaque (dimensions: 18 inches wide by 12 inches high by 10mm thick) shall record the date of construction, the name and the occupation of the first resident, and the logo of the Nasagiweya Historical Society, as per the sample displayed on the NHS website.

I/we agree to install the plaque in an appropriate and clearly visible location on the façade of my/our building; and that the maintenance of the plaque shall be my/our responsibility.

Please know that participation in the NHS Historical Plaque Program does not involve property heritage designation by the Town of Milton, or any other municipality in Halton County under the Ontario Heritage Act. These are decorative plaques, and do not bind the property in any way.
