CONDITIONS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS

The Award

The Youth Citizenship Award is given in recognition of outstanding contributions made by young women to home, school, community, and country. It is **not** a scholarship but an "award of merit" to be used at the discretion of the recipient in any manner that will best further her aims and purposes. The cash award is given in a single payment to the recipient at the SIERV Annual Awards Event.

Criteria for this award

Applicant must have taken an active part in service in the home, school, and community, with a high degree of cooperation, courtesy, and consideration of others.

Eligibility and Qualifications

To be eligible, the applicant must be in the last year of high school, or its equivalent, and live within the Eel River Valley. The Soroptimist Club of Eel River Valley must receive completed applications by **January 15th**.

Other Requirements

- Applicant must complete the official Soroptimist Youth Citizenship Award application.
- Letters of reference from two adults, not related to the applicant, must be included with the official application.
- Applications and supporting information become the property of Soroptimist International of Eel River Valley (SIERV), which shall have discretionary authority in all matters pertaining to this award. SIERV members will not be judges for this award.
