Spiritual Qualifications:

- Exhibiting a rapport and understanding of students
- · Delivering instruction that is effective and varied
- Engaging students in active learning
- II. Manage the learning environment by
- · Maintaining a safe classroom environment
- Establishing a classroom environment conducive to learning
- · Using time efficiently with both instructional and non instructional tasks
- Redirecting students from inappropriate to appropriate behavior, or from off task to on task behavior
- Being flexible as you may need to teach multiple different classes in one day
- III. Follow professional practices in adherence to school policies by
- Fulfilling morning, lunch, and afternoon duties as assigned
- Helping support the front office staff as needed
- Fulfilling carpool, hall, parking lot, and restroom duties as assigned

- Quickly adapting to teaching various grades and subject matters
- · Supervising students outside the classroom
- Interacting in a Christlike manner toward students, parents, and colleagues
- · Communication with parents and administrators in a timely manner
- Maintaining confidentiality of student information
- Attending required faculty and worship meetings
- Adhering to JICS teacher expectations as defined by the staff handbook
- Maintaining regular and prompt attendance
- Consistently modeling Christ for students
