Student participation in any Dual Enrollment program is a student choice. Because this choice exists for students, it is the responsibility of the student and parent/guardian to be knowledgeable about the program, admissions requirements, and effects upon high school graduation, GPA, eligibility, and class rank.

Dual Enrollment (DE) students will agree to the following:	Student Initials	Parent Initials
DE students are responsible for completing and submitting a DE application packet and completing all enrollment requirements of the college on time.		
VVCS admin will determine if DE classes meet VVCS requirements.		
DE students must consider if extracurricular commitments will interfere with the completion of college coursework.		
College courses may be quarter-long or semester-long commitments. Dropping/withdrawing from a college course in the middle of a quarter/semester could result in the student receiving an F on the college an/or VVCS transcript, not graduating on time, and/or removal from DE.		
Colleges do not follow the VVCS calendar. Students are responsible for their college schedules and honoring attendance requirements at both institutions.		
DE students are responsible for monitoring their own grades and progress in their college courses. VVC does not share grades with VVCS until the course is completed and all grades are final.		
DE courses will affect a student's college GPA when transferred to a full-time college.		
DE students are responsible for completing all VVCS graduation requirements. A DE student may not graduate or participate in the graduation ceremony if: • A student fails a DE course needed for graduation w/o doing credit recovery. • A student does not register for the correct DE courses to meet graduation requirements. • A student withdraws from a DE course needed for graduation w/o doing credit recovery
