

## Victor Valley Christian School Dual Enrollment Permission Form

Parents: Please read carefully, sign, and return to the school office prior to Step 2. Dual enrollment is for students who are on the college track and would like to get a head start on completing some of their college general education and/or graduating high school with their AA. Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, cannot have any failed classes, and must have satisfactory attendance at VVCS.

There are several factors to be aware of prior to applying for dual enrollment at VVC.

- 1. VVC is a public community college; therefore, course content is not presented from a biblical worldview. VVCS has no control over VVC's course content.
- Classes taken at VVC will be recorded on your child's permanent college transcript.
   VVCS has no authority over the assignments required in the college class nor the grades received by your child for those assignments. Any issues will have to be addressed to VVC, not VVCS.
- 3. It is your child's responsibility to adhere to the expectations of the college class, including the schedule of when assignments are due to be turned in.
- 4. When students are concurrently enrolled in college classes, the student will earn high school credit for that class, as well. Keep in mind that if they fail the college class, it will be recorded as a failing grade on their high school transcript.
- It is the student's responsibility to request their transcripts from VVC to be sent to VVCS in a timely manner so that VVCS can record these classes/grades on the high school transcript.

Please fill out and return to the school office. Once it is received, students will be given a Dual Enrollment Application.
