Founder Region Fellowship is almost completely supported financially by our members so I want to share with you all the ways your can ensure Fellowship is around for the next 75 years.

Here are the ways your club can support our mission.

- Make Fellowship contributions a line item in your Club
 Budget so you can name a Fellow annually or bi-annually.
 - \$1,000/year and name a Fellow every year
 - \$500/year and name a Fellow every 2 years
 - Budget for more than one Fellow/year to honor more members.
 - Donate any amount in honor of your board members for their service. We will track their account

- Update your bylaws to make Fellowship your "charity of choice" for memorial contributions for members and their immediate families.
- Honor your members with donations to Fellowship for club milestone anniversaries and special recognitions.
- Recruit members for your club team to support the Fellowship Fun Run in April. This is an annual event and is a big money maker for Fellowship.

The more you talk about and support Fellowship, the more your members will find value in our mission.

Last year we launched the 75 Year Diamond Jubilee Fundraising

Campaign and raised over \$10,000 additionally from member

donations. We are continuing this campaign for another year and hope to raise another \$10,000 to fund our Fellowship grants.

- Donate \$75 or more toward this campaign.
- If at least 12 of your club members each donate \$75, whether they are a Fellow or not, your club can name a Fellow, which is a discount of \$100. Now if your club already budgets to name a Fellow every year, we hope that you will do this in addition to the individual member donations.
- Last year's donations count toward the club so if you fell short of the 12 needed last year, you still have time. Members can donate more than once and will be counted toward this

incentive.

All donors over the biennium will be entered into a drawing to win a Fellow (or level up), be posted on a special Anniversary Page on the Fellowship Website and receive Special Recognition at the 2024 Founder Region Conference In May.

- But wait, there more...


