

Sunday Discipleship Group

Our mission at fellowship is to engage our communities and beyond with the life-changing gospel and love of Jesus Christ. One way this is accomplished is by growing in community. This is our opportunity to become more effective disciples of Jesus Christ.

Parents and guardians, we believe that you are the primary disciplers of your children and youth, but we are thrilled to come alongside you and support you in that responsibility through our Sunday discipleship group. This group will provide an opportunity for strong discipleship with the youth (6th-12th graders) and will meet during the 9:30 service.

In the discipleship group, we will deal with relevant truths. As we dig deep into scripture, we will mostly use the Discovery Bible Study (DBS) model of studying a passage:

1. Read and listen to the passage multiple times
2. Retell the story in your own words (verbally or writing it down)
3. Discover the story by rethinking and discussing the following questions:
 - What does this story tell you about God?
 - What does this story tell you about people?
 - If this is really God's word, what changes would you have to make in your life?
 - Who are you going to tell?

Expectations

Anyone who desires to attend this group must have a desire to grow and intentionally deepen their walk with Christ.

We will challenge the youth to own and grow in their faith by:

Listening to the lead pastor on Sunday mornings

- Students will learn the same teachings their parents heard, providing opportunities for families to have good discussions together.
- Allows for students to connect with the larger church body.

Taking notes during Sunday's message in the main auditorium

- This teaches them to care about what's being taught.
- Obtaining a nice journal would be recommended for the parents to get their youth, fellowship can assist if needed.

Reviewing the message from the week before

- This will be another avenue to retain and remember what's being taught.

Sitting together as a youth group in the auditorium

- Provides camaraderie and a healthy and encouraging atmosphere of other young adults learning together with the rest of the church body.

Doing daily quiet times throughout the week

- Scripturing reading and praying (for others and themselves)
- We will ask that they take notes of their prayers and scripture readings so they can be held accountable as we share the ways God speaks to us.

Memorizing Scripture

- One scripture a week
